The Process: Case Review and Background

- Quality Check of DNA; DNA Was from a Single Source
- Verification No Match Existed in CODIS
- Excellent Results from Genotyping at DNASolutions

Genealogy Begins

- Who are we looking for? A White Guy
- Several "Ok" matches in the 3rd to 4th cousin range
 - A 3rd cousin shares a g-g-grandparent with you
 - A 4th cousin shares a g-g-grandparent with you
 - How much of YOUR ancestral pedigree can you identify?
- Our Top Match had an Unknown Parentage in Appanoose County, Iowa
- Other matches were identified with roots in Polk, Tama, Lucas, and Warren Counties
- The Goal: Find a Common Ancestor Among the Matches and identify a "union couple"
- The Most Helpful Tool: What Are The Odds?
- Newspaper Articles Focus My Attention on One Particular Family
- A Bit of Miscommunication!
